Re: Temporary Entry Permits (TEPs) issued by CA Department of Water Resources

In an effort to keep our Delta members informed of ongoing activities of the Bay Delta Conservation Plan, this memo offers some additional information that may be helpful to you.

The California Department of Water Resources has issued another round of Temporary Entry Permits (TEP) to Delta landowners in the last few weeks. As you are aware the Delta Caucus (comprised of the five Delta County Farm Bureau's) met with the Department of Water Resources (DWR) early in the process to suggest modifications to the Temporary Entry Permit (TEP). As of result of those meetings some modifications have occurred to TEPs, but several issues remain at large and are unanswered by DWR.

If you have received a TEP, we strongly encourage you to seek legal advice. The Central and South Delta Water Agencies have offered to assist all Delta landowners and their attorneys to defend against DWR's entry onto your property. You may call Thomas Keeling at (209) 474-1818. The firm is willing to assist in this matter regardless of the part of the Delta your property resides.
