Overview of Entities and Participation Opportunities

Our Entities

- The Sacramento County Farm Bureau (SCFB), a 501(c)5 nonprofit, has been a grassroots membership organization since 1917, focusing on preserving and protecting our agricultural economy and rural lifestyle. Farm Bureau focuses on advocacy, consumer education, media relations and membership services. We strive to be the voice of our agriculture community, so that our members can focus on their farms, ranches, and families.
- The YF&R is a committee under SCFB for young people between the ages of 18-35 who are committed to advocate for agriculture. YF&R provides networking opportunities, leadership development, industry education, and community service/outreach opportunities for its members.
- The Sacramento Farm Bureau Foundation for Agricultural Education (Ag Foundation) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit which provides scholarships for high school and university students pursuing a degree in agriculture and supports agricultural education activities throughout the county.

SCFB Events

- Farm Safety Seminar: This seminar provides farmworker safety training in Spanish within a disadvantaged area of the county. Seminar includes a broad range of safety topics for both owners/managers/supervisors and farm workers. An employer session in English provides updates on regulatory compliance for businesses and employing workers.
- Annual Dinner: Celebration and recognition of our Agricultural Members and brief business meeting for the election of the SCFB Board of Directors.
- Drive-Thru Dinners: Freshly cooked dinner ready to take home and enjoy.
- Member Appreciation Event: Special thank you social for our members.

YF&R Events

- YF&R BBQ: Main fundraiser for leadership development of our young farmers and ranchers, scholarships for high school seniors, and support for 4-H and FFA students at the Sacramento County Fair Junior Livestock Auction.

Ag Foundation Events

- Winemaker's Dinner: Main fundraiser for funding the Ag Foundation's Scholarship Program. Enjoy an evening featuring an elegant four-course meal accompanied with custom wine-pairings.

Additional Participation Opportunities

- Farm Bureau Membership: Receive published and electronic updates and information of SCFB activities, CA FB legislative progress, and the Ag industry. Business membership

includes a listing in the SCFB Business Directory in the Bulletin publication, website, and SCFB app and opportunities to provide resources to SCFB members.

- Foundation to Agricultural Education Fund: Directly contribute to the educational program and scholarship program. The educational program helps improve and enhance the agricultural education programs at elementary, secondary, and post-secondary levels through training teachers, providing students direct contact with agriculture, and promoting student understanding of the role of Agriculture throughout California. The Scholarship program includes 3 scholarship areas:
 - Academic Scholarship: Designed for students majoring in agricultural related areas such as Animal Science, Biotechnology, Veterinary Medicine, Ag Business, and Aquaculture.
 - Agriculture Employee Scholarship: Designed for children of agricultural employees pursuing a college education in any area of study.
 - Career Technical Education Scholarship: Designed for students majoring in an agricultural related or food related field such as Baking and Pastry, Culinary Arts, Culinary Management, Diesel, Heavy Equipment, Vet Tech, and Welding.
